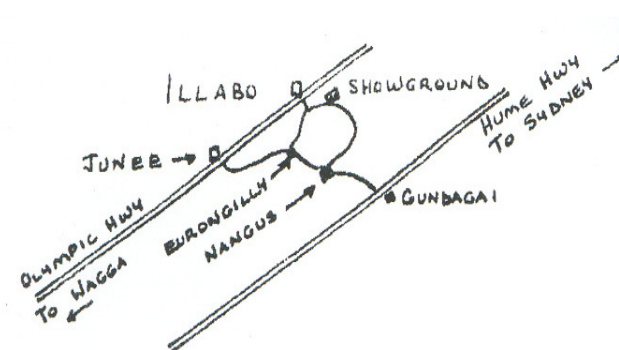

RULES

IMPORTANT... PLEASE READ ALL THE RULES AND NOTES CAREFULLY BEFORE FILLING IN THE ENTRY FORM, TAKING PARTICULAR NOTICE OF NEW NOTE NUMBER ONE (1)

1. Winners of any one section are not eligible to enter that same section the following year, but may enter other sections.
2. You may perform only once in any section.
3. All sections are for amateurs or semi professionals only.
4. Junior entrants are not permitted to enter Senior Sections.
5. No backing bands or drum machines allowed. Backing band supplied.
6. Solo artists not accompanying themselves, may be accompanied by one musician and/or the Backing Band. Solo artists accompanying themselves may have the Backing Band if they wish.
7. Judges decisions will be final. No correspondence will be entered into.
8. Late entries will be accepted at \$10.00 per entry if positions are available.
9. All names in Duo/Group Section must be on entry form. No changes will be made on the day. Forms with only one name will not be accepted.

NOTES

- (1) Entrants are advised to have more than one song ready for each section they enter so there is NO REPETITION of any song in any one section.
- (2) Some entrants in the past have been confused as to what constitutes an Australian Bush Ballad and a Gospel song, so we have included the following explanations as guides;

Bush Ballads ... A Ballad is a story therefore an Australian Bush Ballad should be a song with relevance to Australian Country Life, and/or its People and Places.

Gospel...The word Gospel means “Good News” and is used mainly in relation to the Good News as found in the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. Therefore the songs chosen should be relevant to the Christian Faith.
